

Triple helix model for networking with impact




Business with a high level of expertise requires close co-operation between universities, enterprises and the public sector.



- > case Sandvik: The employment impact of the Turku office was about 2,000 people in 2017, with an annual increase of about 500 people
- in 2018 established Battery Electrification Innovation and Development Center for loaders and trucks in Turku
- Valmet Automotive hired more than 3,000 employees in 2014–2018 totalling now almost 5000.
 Opens in late 2019 a new battery production center, 300 new employees.
