#### The EU's funding and financing offer: new tools for a new decade

Session 1 will provide a better understanding on the latest EU funding schemes for clean energy technology and answer energy community's specific questions regarding 2 types of EU funds. This will ensure the identification of the most suitable funding (or funding combination) for their project ideas.

#### It will focus on:

- InvestEU: New Opportunities in the Clean Energy Sector to Boost Investment,
   Innovation and Job Creation
- **ETS Innovation Fund**: Driving Innovative, Low-Carbon Technologies Towards the Market





## National / regional funding opportunities: exploitable synergies to accelerate the clean energy transition

This session will present, through a transversal perspective, the **additional funding opportunities** which **finance clean energy technologies** at the **national** or **regional** level. It will focus particularly on the **ESIF / ERDF opportunities**, the brand new **Just Transition Mechanism** and more precisely, on how these funding schemes can be **combined** with others.

It will conclude with a 10-minute Q&A session, enabling participants to react to the concrete examples presented during this session and to interact directly with the speakers.





#### **Unlock Private Funding for clean energy demonstration projects**

Session 3 will provide participants deeper knowledge on private funding for clean energy technologies and define typical preconditions that demonstration projects should gather in order to get private funding.

**3 private finance providers** will share their views during a panel discussion on how to unlock private funding for energy demonstration projects.

#### Key topics include:

- Insurance and guarantee schemes from public bodies to cover the technology risk of energy demonstration projects
- How public money can leverage private capital in general.

#### LIVE ((O))

Live questions will be presented to participants who will express their views on private funding for the clean energy sector. The audience will answer short questions or vote on a specific statement, feeding the discussion among the 3 private finance providers, who will react based on the answers of the audience.

### How to successfully access funding schemes to achieve clean energy transition and the EU 2030 climate targets?

EUREC and ZABALA will present two of the main findings of the SMARTSPEND project, through the reports "Funding instruments for energy transition" and "Alternative funding instruments."

This session will provide hands-on **feedback** from 2 successful applicants on their **experiences, recommendations** and **best practices** with related funds.

Key questions will be addressed, such as:

- How to reduce financing cost for early-stage technologies?
- How to deploy support for roll-out technologies that are not commercial yet?

Session 4 will also be complemented with a discussion with an **EC representative** on updates on the **EU 2030 climate targets** and related objectives for energy demonstration projects.
