## **MEETING VENUE**

Rathaus City Hall, Lichtenfelsgasse 2, Feststiege II, 1st Floor, 1010 Vienna, Austria.

- On 11/10: Registration opens at 11:00, the Forum starts at 12:00 and ends at 20:30.
- On 12/10: Registration opens at 07:30, the Forum starts at 08:45 and ends at 18:45.

Please note that all the conference rooms are located on the 1st floor.

## **REGISTRATION**

Upon arrival at the venue, our conference assistants will ask you for one of the following elements. This will grant you access to the Forum:

- A proof of vaccination
- A proof of past infection/recovery
- A doctor's certificate not older than 6 months, OR
- A positive antibodies test not older than 3 months
- A negative PCR test (Validity: 48h)

Please be aware that FFP2 masks are mandatory in all public transports and also during the Forum. FFP2 masks will also be available at the entrance of the venue.

Kindly go straight to the registration desk located on the 1st floor and prepare your ID or passport.

A cloakroom will be at your disposal on the 1st floor as well as a luggage storage area if needed.

Please always keep your badge in sight when circulating between the different spaces during the Forum. Thank you!

## **COVID-19 government measures**

Please be aware that you will have not only need to comply with the Austrian entry regulation but also to comply with the Covid-19 government measures in place in Vienna at the time of the Forum.

# **GETTING TO THE VENUE**

#### Train:

## Taxi:

Taxis with a taximeter are permanently available in front of the arrivals' hall. The fare from the airport to the city centre of Vienna is normally around €45 and takes approximately 20-30 min, depending on traffic. Note that due to the Covid-19 prevention measures in place, taxis can only accommodate 2 passengers.

#### Bus:

Line VAL 1 is running from 03:30 AM to 20:30 PM every hour from Wien-Schwechat Airport to Vienna Central Station.

## Bus:

Line VAL 1 is running from 03:30 AM to 20:30 PM every hour from Westbahnhof of Vienna Central Station to Vienna airport.

Line VAL 3 (Donauzentrum) is running at 6:28 / 8:28 / 10:28 / 12:28 / 15:28 / 17:28 from the Donauzentrum to Vienna Airport.

#### **CATERING**

Please note that refreshments will be at your disposal during the event.

Kindly note that lunch is not provided on Tuesday 12 October. However, you will have the possible to purchase food at the venue.

## **CLOAKROOM**

Please note that one cloakroom is available at the venue and located upstairs the staircase. The floor is called "Halbstock" (mezzanine).
