Showcasing two "Clean Alpine Regions" – CLAR St. Johann and CLAR Kufsteinerland

Tyrol's mountains, its clear streams and lakes, lush meadows and blooming alpine pastures are a natural gem and the basis for people's livelihoods. Climate protection and sustainability are therefore of particular importance to Tyrol. Even more so: Tyrol wants to become one of the most climate-friendly regions in the Alps.

Decarbonising energy systems, reorganizing mobility, preserving and protecting biodiversity and a sustainable economic development including social justice and ecological responsibility, all play an essential role.

In the project Clean Alpine Region, or CLAR for short, the four CLAR regions Kaunergrat, Kufsteinerland, Sankt Johann and Pitztal demonstrate how this can be accomplished. In their efforts, they are supported by the state

agencies Energie Tirol, Tirol Werbung and Standortagentur Tirol. On the local level, CLAR managers coordinate all actions and required processes.

But sustainability measures not only serve to protect the climate. The CLAR regions recognise the importance of sustainable action for their economies in general (as they increase the potential for innovation) and for the future of tourism by ensuring an intact environment as a foundation for all tourism offers.

On this field trip, two of the CLAR regions will give you an insight into their efforts and you will catch a glimpse of Tyrol's nature, culture and history.
