GS Taiwan - Application deadlines (Canada)

Canadian registration

November 8, 2021

- Necessary to 'onboard' new IRAP clients and provide preliminary advice

Canadian expression of interest

November 15

- To get early indication of eligibility to IRAP funding;
- To allow access for national funding application (online)

International consortium (Eureka) proposal

December 15 @ 17:00 Brussels time

Canadian national funding proposal

January 5, 2022

NRC IRAP funding eligibility for international projects

The Canadian applicant must:

- be an incorporated, profit-oriented small or medium-sized business in Canada,
- have 500 or fewer full-time equivalent employees,
- pursue growth and profit by developing and commercializing innovative, technology-driven new or improved products, services or processes in Canada,
- have a differentiated and protectable technology that could become competitive in global markets,
- have sufficient working capital and resources to undertake a multi-year R&D collaboration and commercialize the results, and
- be committed to significant growth through international market expansion.

NRC IRAP funding eligibility - preference

Preference may be given to SME applicants who:

- have a minimum of 15 full-time equivalent employees,
- have commercialized one or more products domestically or internationally, and
- have greater than \$500,000 CAD in annual revenue.
