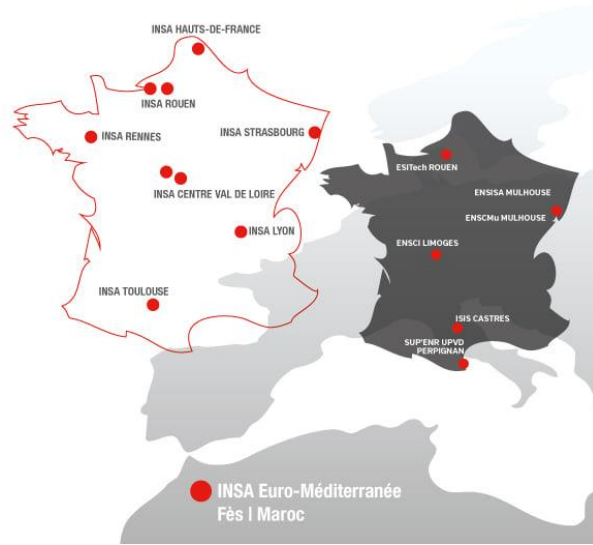

5 year curriculum to obtain an engineering degree



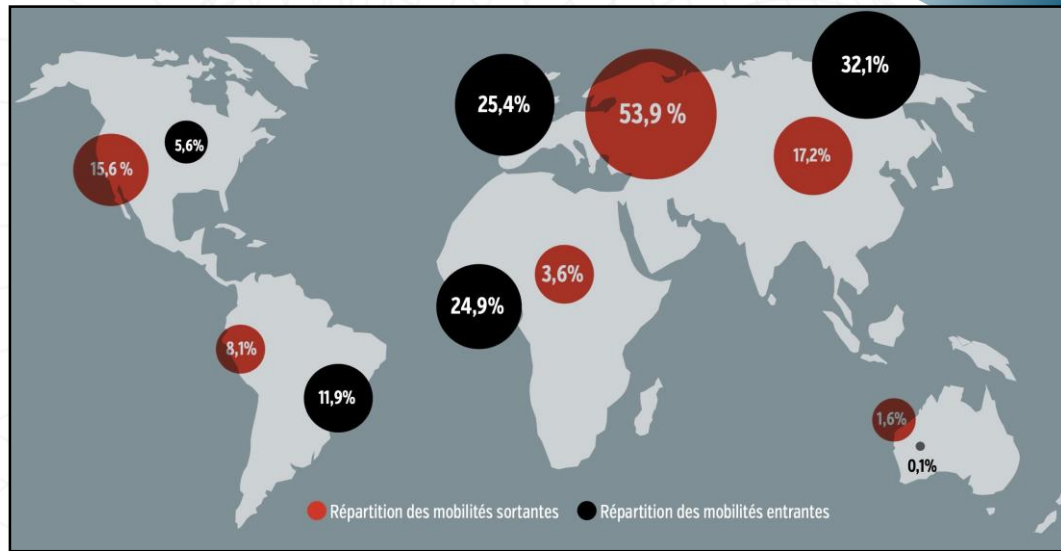
7 INSA Campuses in France

Highly selective recruitment post-bac (10%)



International activity (Education)

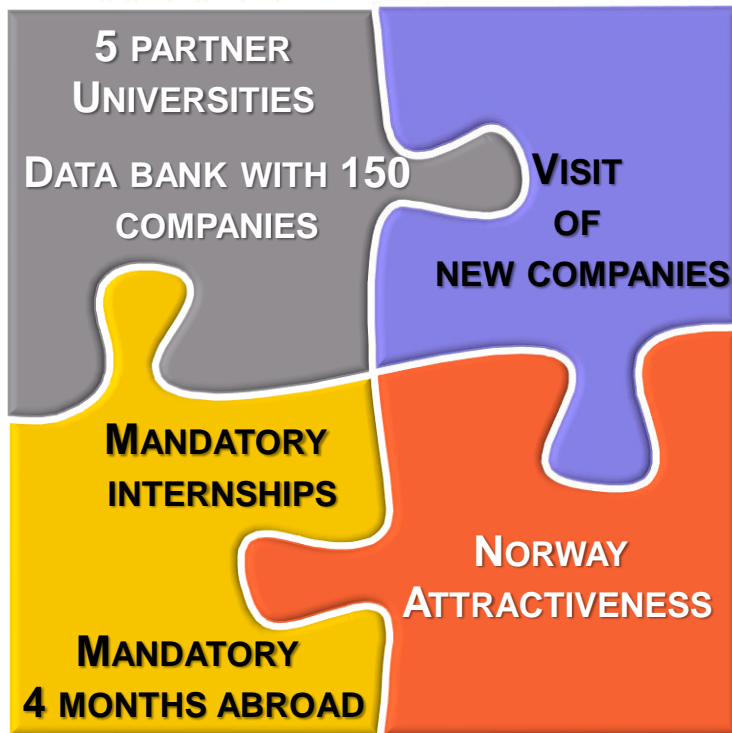
- ▶ **218 university partners** in about 50 countries, including 32 with double degree agreements
- ▶ **Mandatory international mobility : 21 weeks on average**
- ▶ **630 outgoing students/year**
 - ▶ 330 for studies
 - ▶ 300 for an internship
- ▶ Various international programs
 - ▶ **NorgINSA**, ASINSA, EngINSA, ...



- ▶ Around 23% of foreign students (≈ 770)
 - ▶ 36% of whom are women
 - ▶ 14% new entrants in the first year

Status well defined in France:

- *Signed agreement between the
School/Company/Student
- *6 month maximum, full time
- *Financial reward mandatory (600 euros/month)
- *Confidentiality agreement
