This data protection notice is addressed to persons attending the event "LT 5G SANDBOX INFO DAY & IDEAS PITCH AND BUSINESS CONTACTS FAIR" organized by the Ministry of Transport and Communications of the Republic of Lithuania (hereinafter – the event) Vilnius (Lithuania) and online 15 June 2022.

Who is the controller of your personal data?

For what purposes we process your personal data and under what legal basis?

If you decide to attend the event, your personal data will be processed for the following purposes: to organize the event, to manage your participation in the event (including confirming your participation), to identify and invite speakers to the plenary session, moderators and participants, to share event content (video and audio recording) via the live streaming platform, to share event content between participants and receive feedback from them.

The processing of personal data for the specified purposes is based on your consent (Article 6 (1) (a) of the Regulation¹).

During the event video and audio recording for communication purposes will be taken based on your consent (Article 6 (1) (a) of the Regulation).

Participants of the event will be able to actively engage via questions and comments which will be recorded on the conference platform through chat messages (Microsoft Teams). Recorded chat messages and questions sent via the conference platform will only be available to participants and will not be stored after the event.

What kind of personal data do we process?

We process the following personal data if you participate in the event:

Do we share your data with other organisations?

How long will your personal data be stored?

Your personal data and the video and audio recording made during the event will be processed on the B2Match platform until 31 December 2025, after the end of the activities envisaged in the Lithuanian Economic Recovery and Resilience Building Plan "New Generation Lithuania". At the end of the retention period, personal data, video and audio recording on the B2Match platform will be deleted.

Personal data related to participation in the event will be stored for archiving purposes in the Ministry of Transport and Communications for five years after the event. At the end of the retention period, personal data will be deleted.

The video and audio recording made during the event for archiving purposes will be stored by the Ministry of Transport and Communications for five years after the event. At the end of the storage period, the video and audio recording will be deleted.

PHOTOGRAPHY AT THE EVENT

Photographs will be taken during this event. The photos can show, among other things, the participants of the events.

For what purposes we process your personal data and under what legal basis?

If you decide to participate in the event, your personal data as an event participant, if you are visible in the photos, will be processed in order to inform public about the event through external communication channels (Ministry of Transport and Communications social media accounts (Facebook, Linkedin, Twitter, Youtube), on the website of the Ministry of Transport and Communications, etc.), to prepare articles for the media and other texts for social networks, on the website of the Ministry of Transport and Communications, etc., which may be published together with photos taken during the event.

The processing of personal data for the specified purposes is based on the legitimate interests of the Ministry of Transport and Communications (Article 6 (1) (f) of the Regulation). What kind of personal data do we process?

If you are seen in the photos, your image will be processed.

Do we share your data with other organisations?

How long will your personal data be stored?

Photos taken during the event, in which you are visible, are stored and published for ten years from the end of the event. At the end of the retention period, personal data will be deleted.

What rights do you have and how do you exercise them?

As a data subject, you have the following rights:

- 2. the right of access to the data;

- 4. the right to erasure ("right to be forgotten");
- 5. the right to restriction of processing;
- 6. the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.
