

Canada-EU bilateral merchandise trade




- Canadian exports that received tariff reduction from CETA grew 24.6%

Number of Canadian firms that export to the EU, 2016-2019




11.7% of firms exporting to the EU are women-owned

Canadian merchandise exports to the EU by country, 2016 - 2021



Growth in Canadian merchandise exports to the EU by preference margin, 2016 - 2021



Growth in Canadian merchandise imports from the EU by preference margin, 2016 - 2021








CETA ALLOWED FOR CANADIAN EXPORTS TO LOWER THE PRICES OF THE PRODUCTS FOR EU CONSUMERS

Tariff savings for Canadian exports to the EU, 2021




Canada exports to EU: Most unused preferences

EU exporters with the highest utilization rates :









Tariff savings for Canadian imports from the EU, 2021




Canada imports from EU: Most unused preferences

Trade in environmental goods, 2016-2021






CONCLUSION

- Trade between Canada and the EU has seen impressive growth since the provisional implementation of CETA.
- Trade growth was broad-based among products and countries.
- Exports of products that received tariff reductions from CETA grew 24.6 percent between 2016 and 2021.
- The utilization of CETA preferences showed a notable improvement in both trade directions in 2021.
- CETA supports efforts by Canadian and EU member states to fight climate change, leading to a 21.8 percent increase in bilateral trade in environmental goods since CETA.
