Maintaining access to regular health and care services in case of cross-border emergencies - Deadline: 13 Apr 2023; RIA; Single stage evaluation; Budget: 4-6M

Proposal objectives:


- Reinforce the cooperation among transnational and cross-border regions/ and neighboring countries during public health emergencies
- Improve prevention, preparedness and response planning at regional, national, and European levels strengthening the cooperation between neighboring countries
- Promote remote consultations and facilitate the uninterrupted patients flows, assistance and follow ups.
- Facilitate self-monitoring of health status while empowering the patients leaving in cross-border areas.

Proposal of collaboration - Pilot idea

Regular care in the European healthcare systems requires an optimization of the patient flows among the healthcare facilities, especially in cross-border areas and European regions

**Our main goal is:
To provide a Transregional Command Center and Digital Health Emergency
Passport for (pan)-(epi)demics crisis.**

We aim at improving the access to 'regular care' for patients in areas of difficult access, such as the **Pyrenees area**. To achieve this, it is proposed to provide **a telemedicine network** to connect large hospitals within the regions (this will allow the citizens to have continuous access to specialists from high complexity centers). Additionally, we also foresee **a virtual command center** operating beyond the member states borders and able to manage the flow of patients in case of emergency.
