Project ideas


Unobtrusive monitoring of vital functions by evaluation of body micro-vibrations


- Parkinson's disease tremor monitoring
- Care quality, well-being, and stress levels of the elderly and persons with special needs
- Pharmacodynamics monitoring unobtrusive evaluation of effect of drugs on vital functions in real time (anti-depression, sedatives, anti-inflammatory)
- Relative measurements of cardiac output
- Improved accuracy of atrial fibrillation monitoring
- Personal blueprint of human cardiovascular system and its changes – applications in biometrics
- Respiratory effort changes for evaluation of respiratory diseases, detection of various types of breathing
- HRV changes during the inflammation process
- Prediction of development of infections and other contagious diseases



Topics for cooperation

- Studies based on monitoring of persons using wearable technologies and targeted questionnaires based on evaluation of data in real time
- Studies using our server and smart phone (Android & iPhone) application for sending questionnaires and prompts to participants based on given rules and current vital and environment data
- Ecological momentary assessment studies
- Studies involving environment data (based on GPS location and public data sources such as air quality)
- Complex rules created by researchers
- Detailed compliance reports
- Rules based on steps, heart rate, sleep, HRV, active minutes
- Anomaly detection
- Questionnaires & prompts:
 - time-based, in adjustable time windows,
 - immediate,
 - event-triggered by given rules (such as context-based EMA),
 - self-initiated





What we bring into consortium

- Team of persons focused on vital data collection and analysis using advanced statistics and machine learning methods.
- Hardware solution for unobtrusive data collection and evaluation sensor pads and/or wearables measuring HRV, respiration rate, micro-vibrations, pulse wave velocity, ABI index, tremor.
- Software tools for remote vital signs monitoring and mHealth interventions.
- Server and smartphone application for studies management enabling sending questionnaires and prompts based on current data and complex rules.
- Algorithms development based on advanced signal processing.
- Infrastructure for neural networks long-term training & HPC Cluster.
