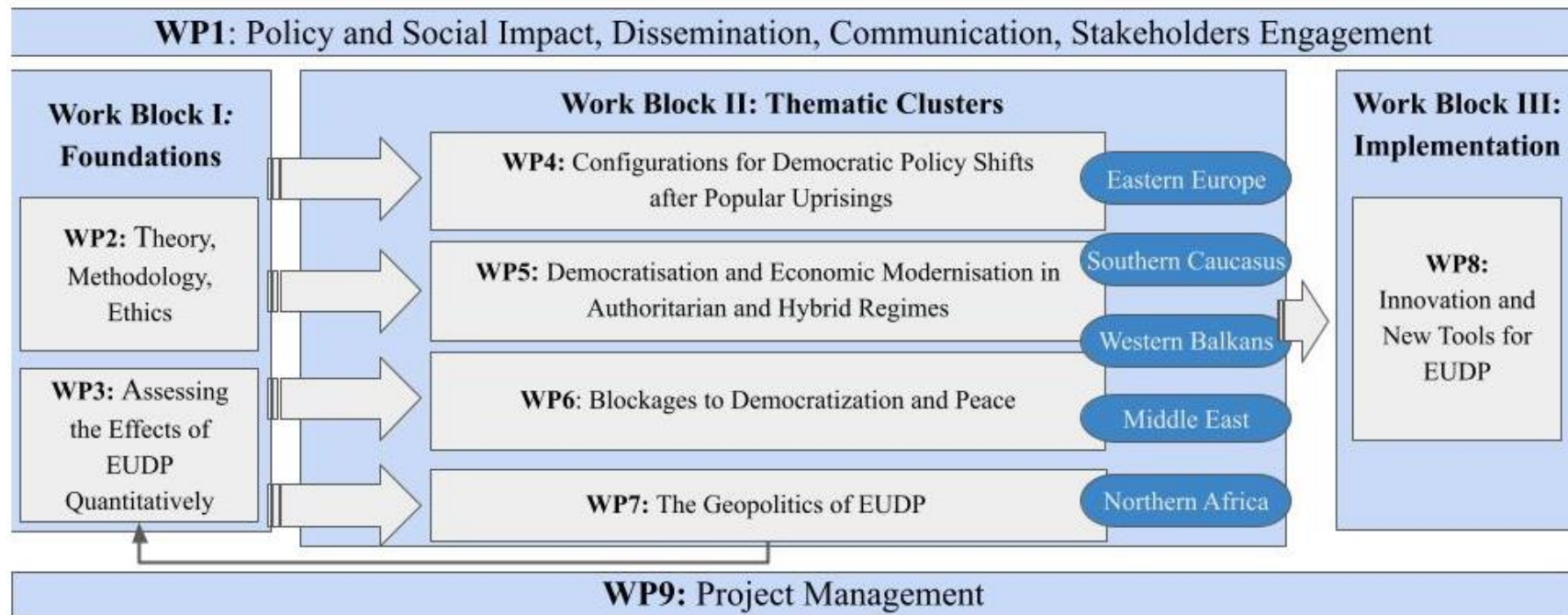

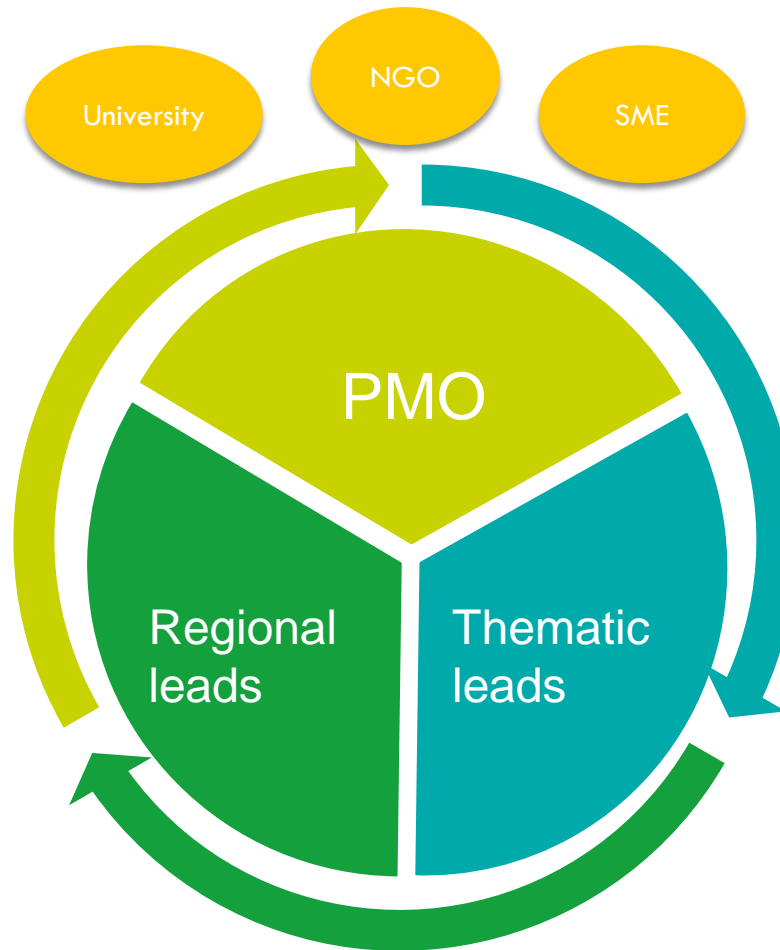

Success factors

Proposal stage

- Experience of previous collaboration; trust and mutual understanding
- Complementary expertise and experience
 - thematic;
 - administrative/budgetary/infrastructure;
 - Impact and stakeholder engagement;
 - scientific and geographic networks

Implementation stage

- Weekly PMO coordination meetings and regular in-person meetings (all PMO members based in Germany)
- Clear division of roles
 - Co: Consortium cohesion, policy/practical impact
 - CCo: Scientific coordination and outreach
- Joint decision-making, co-chairing and alternate hosting of meetings
