EU's main areas of focus in Zambia

The Multi-Annual Indicative Programme - MIP (2021-27)

Three Priority Areas

- Green partnerships for sustainable recovery, growth and decent jobs
- Supporting the people of Zambia to reach their potential and build resilience
- Fair, inclusive and peaceful society.



Zambia and the Erasmus+ Programme

Under the Capacity Building for Higher Education (CBHE) activity, Erasmus+ recently awarded four new grantees in Zambia who include:

- The Copperbelt University (CBU), Levy Mwanawasa Medical University (LMMU), the University of Barotseland and the University of Zambia (UNZA),
- In addition, a CB VET programme on skills development and employability with TEVETA and ILO was recently signed,
- CB VET will work on improving quality of TVET to meet private sector needs and curricula development in agric, mining, energy & tourism.



Role of the EUD in CBHE Action

- Firstly, each Implementing University (IU) in Zambia to appoint a Focal Point (FP) (based on what is foreseen in the contract),
- FP will be interlocutor between EUD, HQ and IU
- FP to provide up-to-date information on implementation of the project and identify opportunities for promotion the Erasmus+ Programme in Zambia,
- FP to share schedule of meetings and general aspects of the project at country level,
- EUD shall participate only in strategic and high level meetings.



Role of EUD cont'd

Prior to final print of communication & visibility
materials, FP to share draft designs with EUD for review,

 A summary of events planned and convened by IUs to be shared with EUD for publication on our social pages,

 Copy of reports submitted to the contracting authority (HQ) to be shared with EUD (for info purposes only).
