HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE GLOBAL GATEWAY

People are at the centre of the Global Gate investment priorities aimed at benefitting people-to-people contacts.

Commissioner Urpilainen has decided to that 10% of the overall budget shall be allocated for Education for the period 2021 – 27 amounting to EUR 6 billion.

Higher Education is supported in addition to Capacity Building in Higher Education, through specific projects on quality assurance and accreditation sharing the European Experience with the rest of the world.



LINKING CAPACITY BUILDING IN HIGHER EDUCATION TO THE GLOBAL GATEWAY

The current Commission (2019 - 2024) has three ambitious goals:

1 climate neutrality by 2050

2 making the 2020s Europe's Digital Decade

3 making Europe stronger in the world with a more geopolitical approach

The two first are directly reflected in Erasmus program and the Global Gateway.

The Global Gateway is part of the third goal - our relationship with partner countries and encouraging people-to-people contacts.
