 Modelling co-morbidities to develop novel and effective therapeutic approaches: diabetes and arthritis (Partner: Fundação Oswaldo Cruz)

The focus of this proposal is on a much-unexplored interaction between diabetes and arthritis. It proposes the development of epidemiological models that will take this critical information as input to help designing phase / clinical trials and model the impact of future intervention programs to control the consequences of diabetes in arthritis people, based on the novel therapies.

The pilot analyses in this model of diabetes + arthritis to a) define the statistical power of the follow-up experiments and b) monitor gene expression products in the lung, heart and joint. Monitor markers of diabetes development in the different settings

Climate Change Impact on Mental Health and its Socioeconomic Drivers

This project has two main objectives: (a) to generate new evidence about the impact of climate change on mental health outcomes in Brazil and in selected European countries, (b) to provide open access to the evidences generated through a web platform in order to make visible the impacts of climate change as well as supporting policy makers with public policy design.

Towards a Resilient Health System

The project proposes a historical analysis of public policy impact on the formation of resilient health systems organized through primary health care (PHC) in areas with vulnerable population. It aims also to identify advances, challenges, threats, and paths for developing a resilient health system to take care of vulnerable population in specific regions in Brazil and selected European Countries.

Income Transfers and Social Mobility

Produce a set of important statistics to understand the evolution of poverty, with a focus on the beneficiaries of income transfer programs. In the case of Brazil, the Programa Bolsa Família (PBF) - the main Brazilian policy for financial support to the most vulnerable - is to be considered. The proposal is to analyze the impact of those income transfer programs on social mobility in selected countries.

Data Sources:

1: Programa Bolsa Família (PBF);

2: Unified Registry for Social Programs (CadÚnico)



ADVANTAGES OF HAVING A BRAZILIAN PARTNER

- The success rate* of eligible applicants from Brazil is 31.25%, which is above the EU average of 21.47%;
- Brazil is in 10th position in participations share in HE among third countries;

- The Brazilian National Health System (SUS) serves more than 190 million people

DATASUS is the database that gathers information about the population under care, providing data on: morbidity, disability, access to services, quality of care, living conditions, and environmental factors. It also provides information on Health Care for the population, registration (Assistential Network) of the hospital and outpatient networks, registration of health facilities, as well as information on financial resources and Demographic and Socieconomic information.
