The EEA and Norway Grants

Objectives of the EEA and Norway Grants

- Contributing to reducing economic and social disparities in the European Economic Area (EEA)
- Strengthening bilateral relations between the Donor States (Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein) and the Beneficiary States
- 2009-2014: 1.8 billion Euro to programmes in 16 countries
- 2014-2021: 2.8 billion Euro to programmes in 15 countries
 - Greece: Euro 116,7 mil.
 - Croatia: Euro 113 mil.

- Aim: Increased value creation, competitiveness and profitability in Greek/Croatian enterprises
- The Programmes offer: non-reimbursable grants to projects for the growth of Greek/Croatian enterprises
 - investments in new processes/ technologies/facilities
 - development of new innovative products/services and support their growth
- **Open Calls**: Projects are selected through open calls and competition.
- Unique **Donor Partnership opportunity** a gateway to new expertise, technology and know-how etc.
- Innovation Norway is fully responsible and operates without any other Greek intermediary body.

Open Call for Proposals on Soft Measures

Aim of the Present Calls on Soft Measures

The aim of the Call is to: Increase the Capacity for Business Development, for Greek and Croatian businesses

Projects must contribute to:

- Increasing the competitiveness of businesses in Greece and Croatia
- Enhancing the collaboration between entities in the Donor States and entities in the Beneficiary States (optional)

Eligible applicants and partners

Eligible applicants

- SMEs, and large companies with no more than 25% public ownership, established as legal entities in Greece or Croatia.
- Not-for profit organizations (including clusters and business associations) established as legal entities in Greece or Croatia.

Eligible partners



For projects in GREECE

<u>Any entity</u> based in **Norway**, **Iceland** or **Liechtenstein** or in **Greece**



For projects in CROATIA

Any entity based in Norway or in Croatia



Grant thresholds and Available Budget per Call

Grant amount requested, per application

- Min € 10,000 ٠
- Max € 200,000 ٠

Only 1 application per applicant (though applicants can also participate as partners in other applications)



Available Budget: EUR 1 000 000

Eligible activities – Must be related to the Focus Areas of each Call

- Training, coaching, mentoring, on various topics
- **Training, coaching and mentoring, specifically targeted to female entrepreneurs** to gain more skills on how to establish or grow businesses
- Organizing workshops, seminars, experience / good practice sharing
- Business matchmaking events aimed at partnerships for business development and capacity building
- Study trips, conferences, workshops, seminars, experience / good practice sharing with the aim of enhancing the bilateral collaboration, networking and learning.
- **Participation in fairs organized in the Donor State(s)** aimed at bilateral partnerships for business development and capacity building.
- Feasibility studies, data collection, analyses



Applicable Grant rates

A. Applicant is a business (economic operator)

De minimis aid – maximum grant rate is 90%

<u>Only if no available quota</u> under de minimis (\notin 200,000 for the past 3 years):

GBER Articles referenced in the Call text

- Aid to SMEs for Consultancy, Article 18 maximum grant rate is 50%
- Aid to SMEs for participation in Fairs, Article 19 maximum grant rate is 50%
- Training aid, Article 31 maximum grant rate is 70%

B. Applicant is a cluster, business association or other nonprofit entity (non-economic operator) The maximum grant rate is 90%

Non-profit entities can submit an application **as long as the project beneficiaries are for-profit entities** (businesses) established in Greece or in Croatia.



Eligible expenses

Eligible direct expenses

- a) Cost of staff assigned to the project
- b) Travel expenses, for activities related to the project
- c) Fees, travel and accommodation costs related to participation in conferences, seminars, training courses, workshops, study visits and other events
- d) Consumables and supplies
- e) Costs related to conducting studies and analyses.
- f) Costs of conferences, seminars and workshops
- g) Costs related to promotional and informational activities
- h) Subcontracting expenses
- Costs arising directly from requirements imposed by the project contract (e.g. dissemination of information, specific evaluation of the project, audits, translations).

Eligible indirect expenses (overheads)

A flat rate of up to 25% of the total direct eligible costs, excluding:

- Direct eligible costs for **subcontracting**
- Costs of resources made available by third parties which are not used on the premises of the Project Promoter or Partner



Project examples

- Organization of a **study trip** on new technologies in sustainable aquaculture for businesses to travel to Norway and become familiar with state-of-the-art sustainable aquaculture processes from Norwegian businesses (**Blue Growth**)
- Participation at Nor-Fishing (Trondheim, 20-22 August 2023) as exhibitor (Blue Growth)
- Attend Nor-Shipping 2023, a maritime trade fair to be held in Oslo between 6-9 June 2023, and organization of a parallel matchmaking session between GR/CRO and NO companies (Blue Growth)
- Organize a workshop on Health and Safety in the maritime sector (Blue Growth)
- Organize a **conference** on AI developments and their implication on ICT applications (**ICT**)
- **Clusters**: increase the competitiveness <u>of cluster members</u> by focusing on the potential of the green innovation and cooperation with Norwegian enterprises. Activities may include training courses, feasibility studies, study trips and conferences
- Applicant that is active in the Blue Growth sector and wants to expand to Norway. Project: Travel to Norway and organize meetings with distributors, clients, etc. to form their export strategy (**Blue Growth**)
- Feasibility study on the potential of floating solar power plants in Greece (Green Industry Innovation)
- Event aiming to bring expertise to Greece/Croatia on Sustainable construction, energy efficiency solutions, etc. (Green Industry Innovation)
- Training/Coaching/Mentoring on Circular Economy principles (Green Industry Innovation)
- Organizing workshops conferences, study trips etc. for enterprises, within the Focus Areas, owned or run by women (supporting <u>women</u> <u>entrepreneurship</u>)





Evaluation and Selection of Projects

Administrative & Eligibility check of applications received

Administrative Criteria

- The project application has been submitted in **English** by the **deadline** set in the respective Call.
- The project application has been submitted via e-mail to the e-mail addresses specified in the Call (Application Form + Mandatory Attachments)

Eligibility Criteria

- The requested grant amount is between €
 10,000 and € 200,000
- All project activities are set to be completed by 30th of April 2024.
- Eligibility of Applicants and Partners (ref. paragraph 1.1 of the Call)



Evaluation criteria for applications received

- Capacity of the Applicant (30%), including human resources, sound financial management and technical feasibility
- **Relevance of the application (40%):** the need for the project is demonstrated, project contributes to increased capacity for business development, contribution towards increased collaboration with the Donor States, activities are eligible and will be implemented in Croatia/Greece or Donor State(s), end beneficiaries identified and committed, cost-to-benefit ratio
- **Transparency (15%):** full and honest accounting of all facts, information, and context regarding expenditure and activities of the project, as well as applicant and partners to enable the Fund Operator to take a justified and fair assessment decision
- **Sustainability (15%):** the project commits to, and includes measures to ensure economic, environmental and social sustainability of the project





The Bilateral Aspect of the Soft Measures Calls

Unique Bilateral Partnerships opportunity

- For GR/CRO applicants: gateway to knowledge, competence, and technology from the Donor States
- For NO/IC/LI partners: insights and access to a new market, form long-lasting partnerships, open ways for future collaboration

Any entity (public or private, for-profit or non-profit) based in Norway (for the Call in Croatia) or in Norway, Iceland, or Liechtenstein (for the Call in Greece) can be a project partner.

Projects involving a Donor Project Partner will score higher during the assessment.


All projects must benefit companies based in Greece or in Croatia and lead to an increased capacity for business development.



Norway grants grants

Travel Support Schemes are open for Greece and Croatia

- **Travel and accommodation expenses**, for Greek/Croatian entities, as well as for entities from the Donor States, who want to **meet potential partners** to develop/submit a joint application under the Calls
- The schemes are open throughout the Call's duration, and until the exhaustion of the available funds
- Lump sums: Euro 1,000 / Euro 1,200 / Euro 1,500
- Apply through the Programme websites for <u>Greece</u> and in <u>Croatia</u>



Partnership projects: What activities could Donor partners implement

- Offer expertise on specific topics (e.g. ESG, LEAN, protection of IPR, Incoterms, Board Member training, or other business-related topic)
- Contribute to a feasibility study, data collection process, sector expertise etc.
- **Co-organize an event** in the Donor State or Beneficiary State
- Mobilise Donor State actors/stakeholders
- Transfer knowledge / share expertise or experiences on topics relevant to the Focus Areas of the Calls
- **Conduct training** (provide trainers, facilitate the training, create the curriculum) on topics relevant to the Focus Areas of the Calls
- **Co-organize a matchmaking event** in the Donor State or Beneficiary State

Norway grants grants

Partnership projects: Examples

- Share of know-how on new Green technologies between Greece/Croatia and the Donor States (e.g. use/production of biodegradable materials, greener production processes, reuse-recycling of materials during production)
- Promotion/transfer of new technologies, energy efficiency measures, automation and digitalization and other innovative processes in Greece/Croatia, particularly for small and micro businesses
- Feasibility studies on a topic within focus areas of the Calls
- Collaboration between clusters within maritime or marine sector. Or learn best practice on how to establish and operate a cluster in a fruitful way for all members.
- Study trip to Donor States showcase and share best practices on i.e.: smart ports, waste collection and sorting, sustainable and environment friendly construction/buildings, reduce/reuse/recycle plastic waste from industry etc.
