in 2022

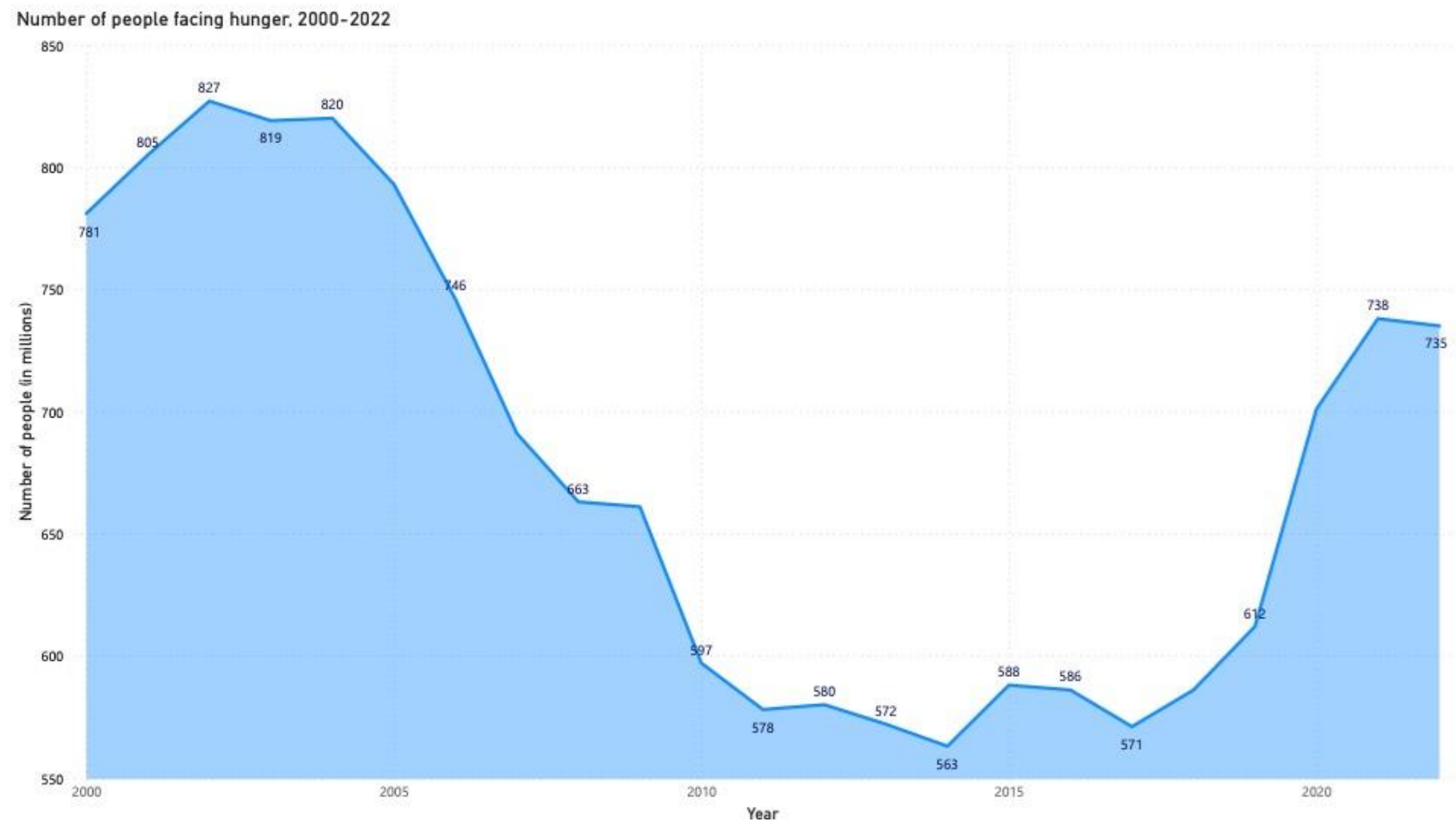
Over **120** countries and

field based

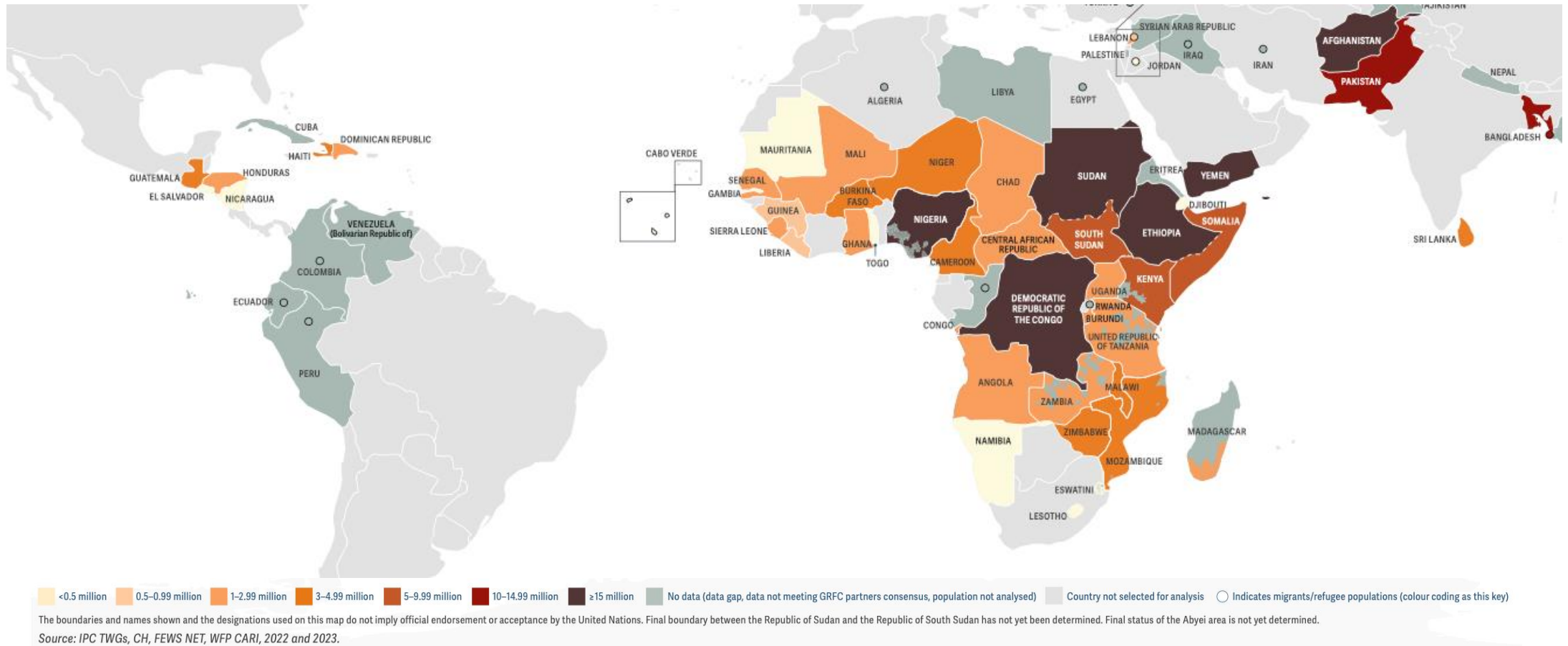
WFP procured **100,000

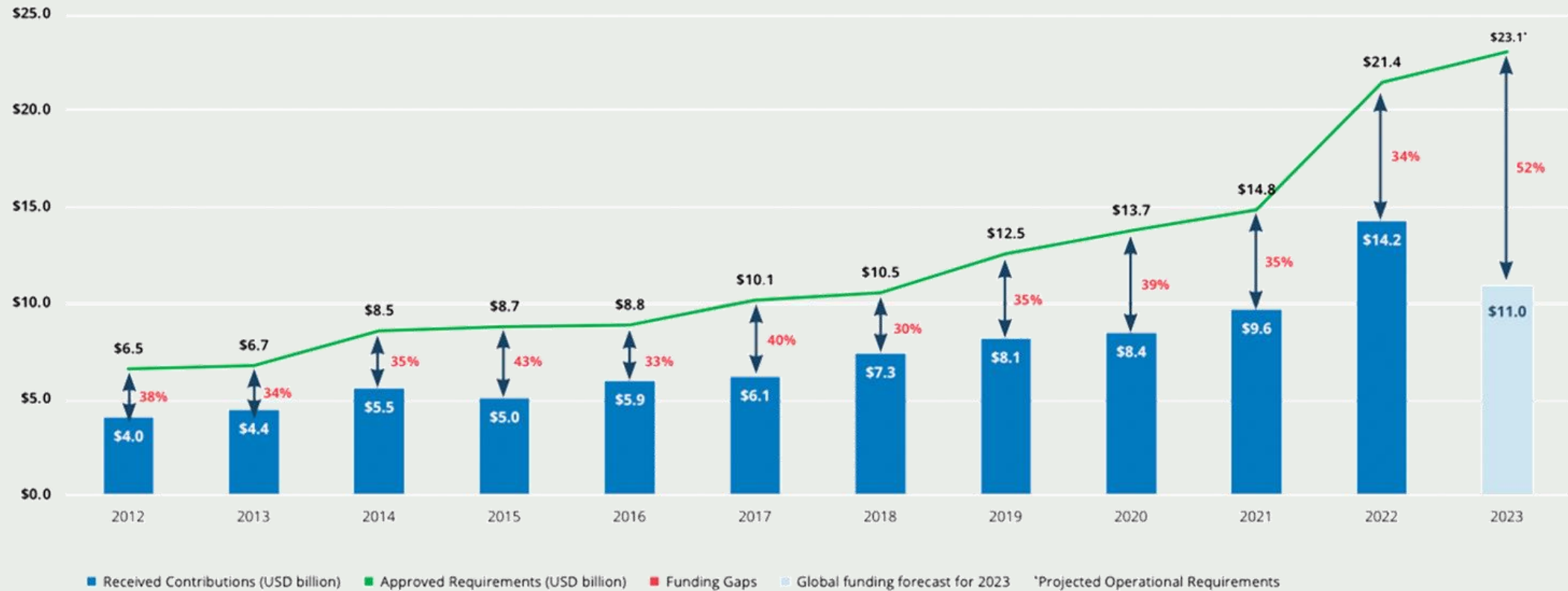

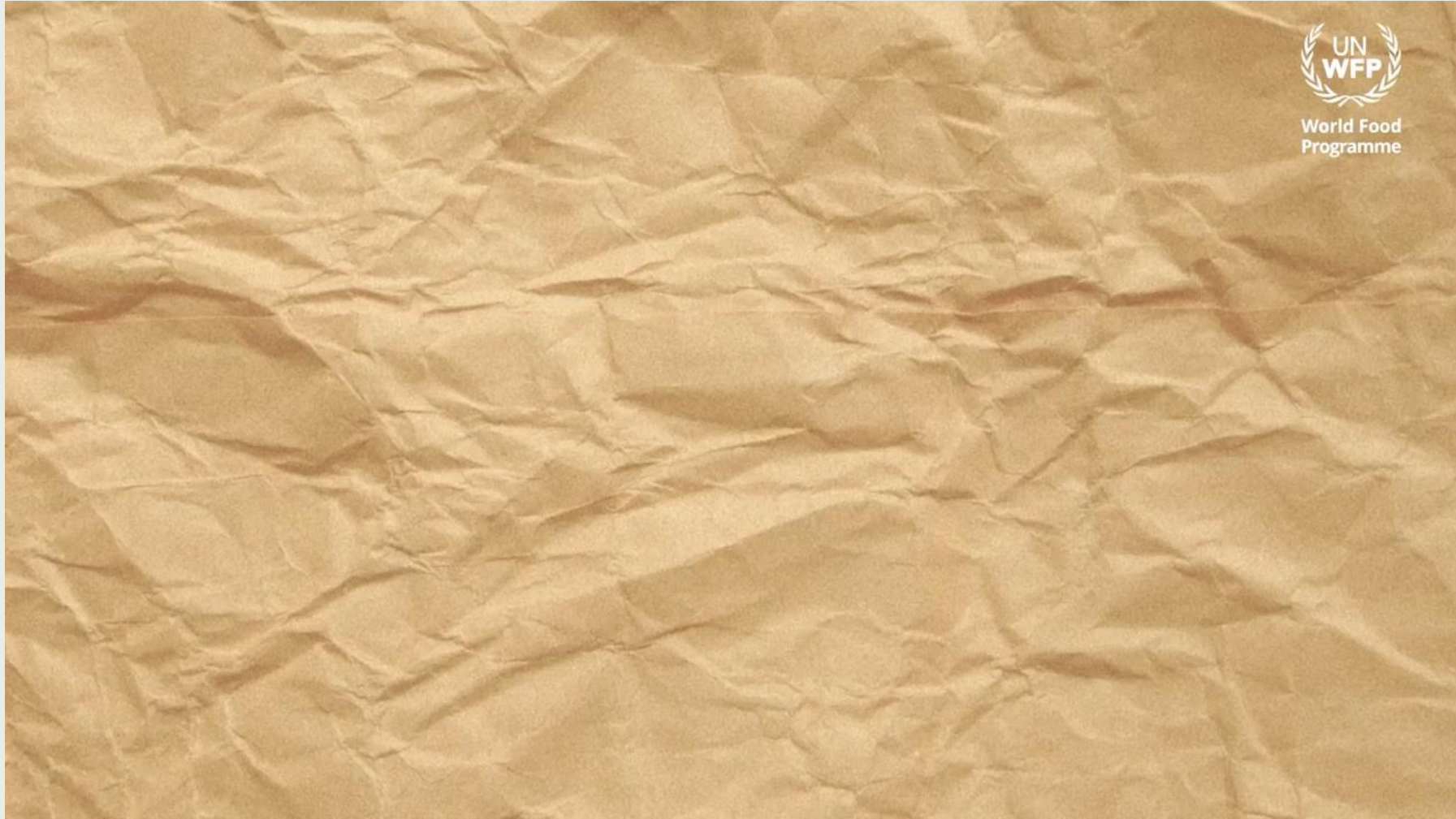

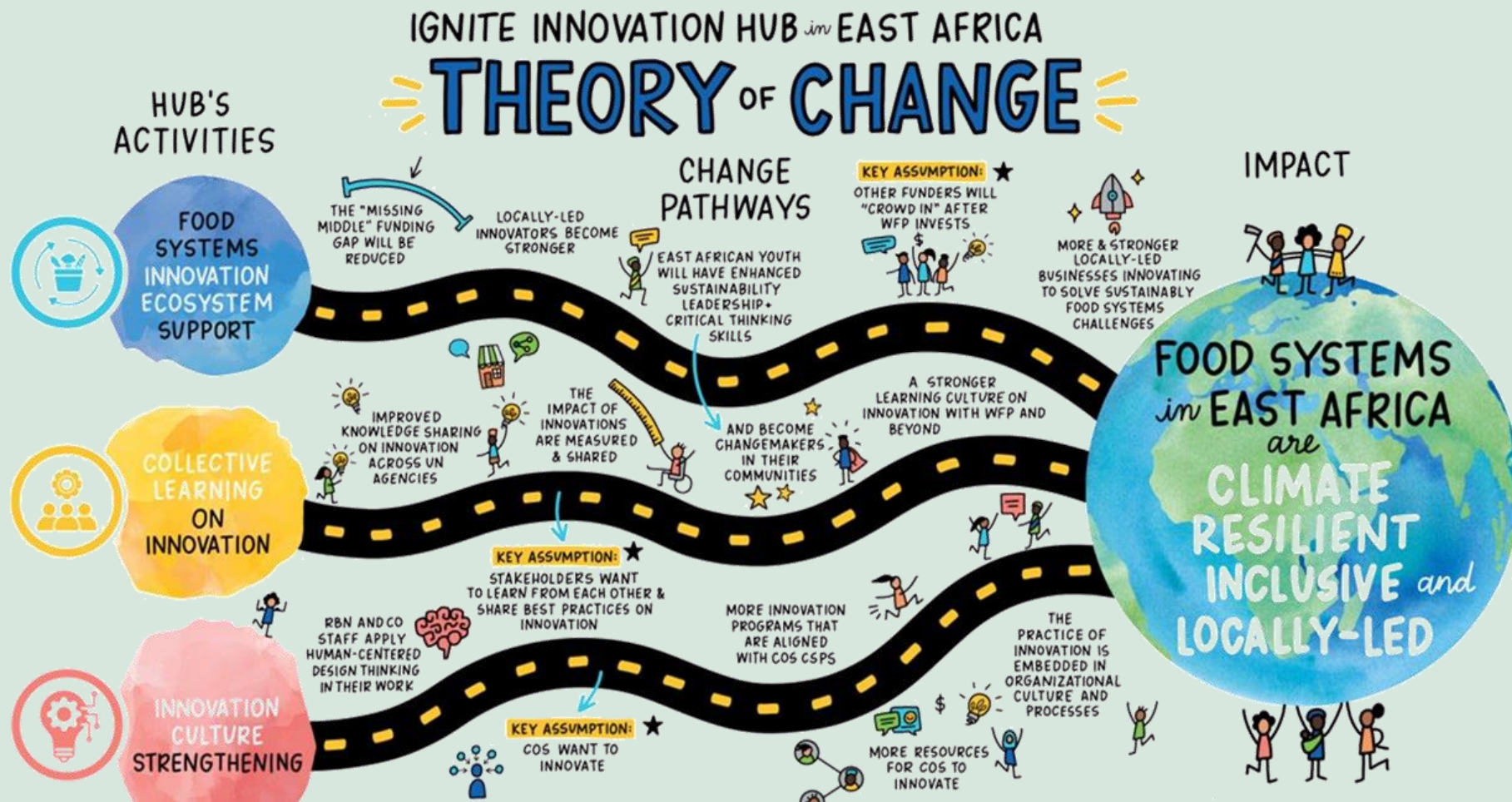
