

Data Protection Notice

Your personal data is processed in accordance with GDPR Regulation (EU) No 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons regarding the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data.

The following entities processes your personal data on our behalf:

The purposes of this processing are to:

- register and manage your application to the “Hack4reSTART” event on THE 24th of May 2023, to the linked Matchmaking event.
- include you in the list of applicants/participants.
- facilitate information about your application and use it to make the final selection.
- provide follow-up to the applicants in order to prepare for the matchmaking event and to manage the matchmaking activities.
- to provide related follow-up activities such as satisfaction surveys, communication concerning the event, post event communication, invitation to next editions, management of lists and mailing-lists for contacts, presentations, live web streaming and/or audio and video recording of speakers and participants.

These elements are mandatory for the purposes outlined above.

Please note that the event may include a preparatory and technical webinar. It is possible that they will be recorded. It is also possible that photographs or screenshots of you will be taken during the event and might be used for online and offline communication activities related to the promotion of the event. If you do not wish to appear on the recording, please do not raise any question orally nor by writing and note that you have the possibility to remain unseen by not activating your video during the event. Upon registration, you can give your explicit consent to have your images/voice recorded and published on related communication channels.

2. To facilitate webinars and plenary sessions, Zoom, a third-party tool managed by InPulse Partners SRL. Some of the data collected is Username, Country, IP, display name, picture, email address, phone number (if provided) and device information. Moreover, it hosts the general collected personal data on servers in the United States for videocalls, it hosts the meetings with data centers in Germany and Netherlands. Your personal data will not be transferred to third countries or international organisations except for data collected by third-party tools (Zoom) with their own privacy policy, which you are strongly suggested to read carefully. Zoom user-generated information is stored in the data centre in United States as provided during the ordering process. Data is replicated across data centers within the same region to ensure availability. Zoom, inc. data, which utilizes Host and Usage Information, is stored in the Netherlands and Germany. Your personal data will be kept for a maximum period of 36 months after the end of the event. Data will be deleted at the end of this period.

The processing of your data will not include automated decision-making (such as profiling).
